Lower Level Gathering Room

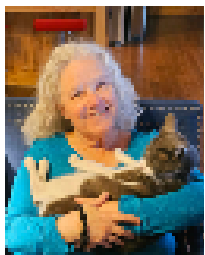
Doors open at **5:00pm**, Meeting Starts at 5:15pm and will conclude about 6:30pm.
