Ways to Support the Shelter



In addition to donating your time and money, there are many other ways to support the shelter. Did you know you can donate your car to benefit us through Charitable Adult Rides & Services (CARS)? In fact, all types of vehicles are considered. CARS, a non-profit organization, strives to accept all types of donated vehicles (running or not) including cars, trucks, trailers, boats, RVs, motorcycles, campers, off-road vehicles, planes, heavy equipment, farm machinery, and most other motorized vehicles.



What are the benefits of donating my vehicle to a nonprofit?

- Donating is easy and the pick-up is free.
- Donating skips the costs and hassles associated with selling a car, like paying for advertising and insurance, or for car repairs to keep your car in running condition while you wait for a buyer.
- It's better than a low trade-in offer.
- Vehicle donations are tax-deductible, and you could reduce your taxable income when taxes are itemized.
- Donating to a nonprofit feels good and makes a difference.
