MOU expires 12/31/23 if MCFA is not building

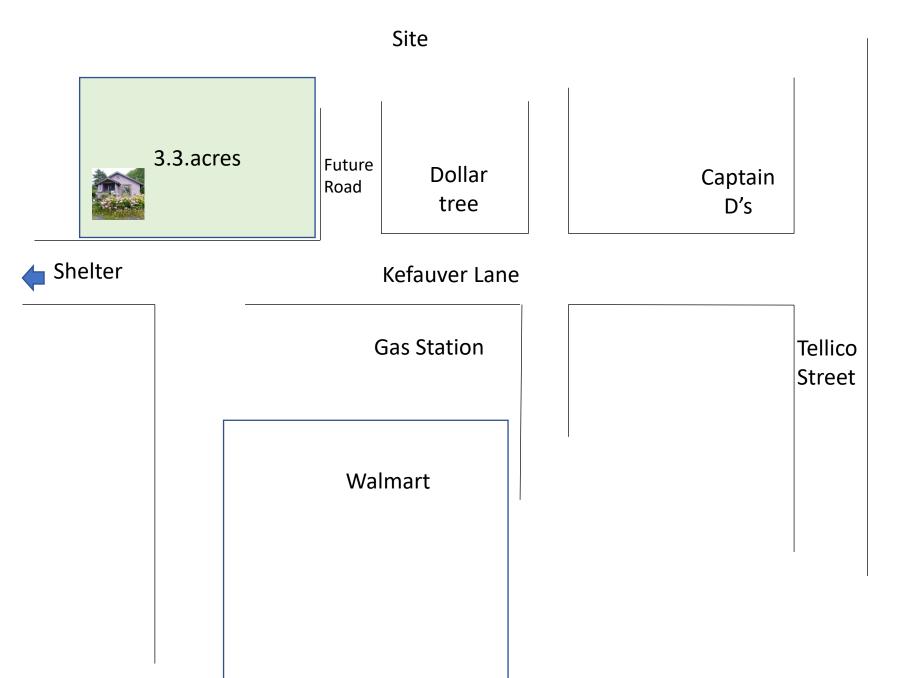

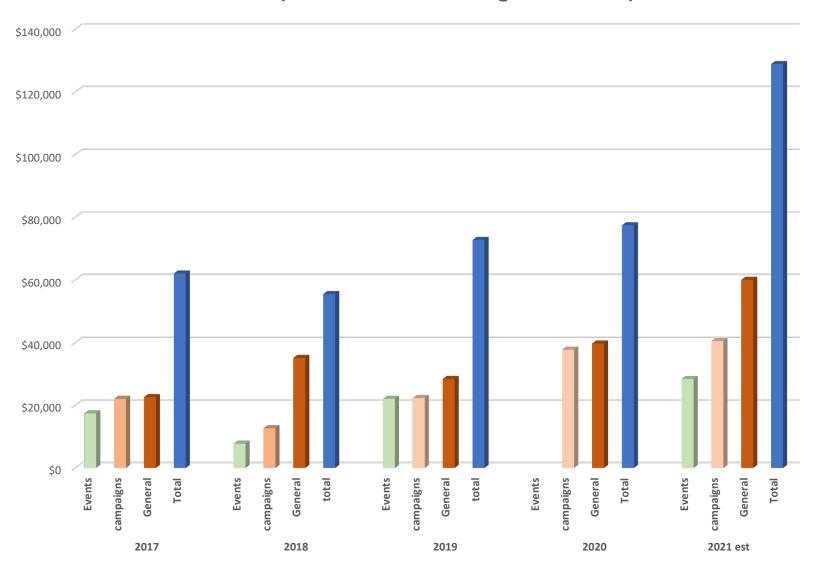
MCFA will provide the same services at the new shelter
